Summary:

Through the use of the ePals Global Community, my students have begun working on a project initiated by another classroom in the United States on the topic of Literature Circles. Students in my class are expected to work collaboratively in small groups and are responsible for conveying information learned with other groups in the class. Three out of the four language domains will be addressed when completing this project including reading comprehension, creative writing, and language communication skills. The outcome of this project will involve students creating their own book reviews to convey their ideas about the book they read. This will provide other students with feedback on books in the classroom library as well as other pieces of literature.

This project will provide a meaningful and successful cross-cultural learning experience through the use of various books that provide ethnic and cultural diversity for students to establish and create meaningful connections to a text of their choice. Students can compare their text to books that other classmates have picked and review the relationships between books. By working cooperatively in small groups, the literature circles will help to create a classroom environment of collaboration, cultural diversity, and awareness through literature. In addition, Literature Circles will also advance students' reading skills by promoting books that are culturally responsive and establishing connections to the text that students have read. Literature Circles will further advance students' skills in writing by having students reflect and evaluate a story and create an authentic response that will review critical components of the text.

ESL Reading is developmentally appropriate for English Language Learners since it tiers the levels of passages based upon their WIDA proficiency levels into low, medium, and high beginners and intermediates. Since the application is provided in twenty three different languages, this would aid families when using the application. However, families would need to know their child's reading proficiency level in order to purchase the appropriate reading package for their child.

Collin's Big Cat: Story Creator is an application designed to develop reading and writing skills for students. The skills that students develop from reading the story can be transferred to writing a story where students are given the opportunity to create their own book using characters and other elements from the story. This application is beneficial to English Language Learners since it provides picture support for the learners and uses animation techniques to aid in story comprehension. At the end of the story, there is also a comprehension quiz to assess what students can recall from the story. In order to aid

families in using this application, there is guidance provided in using this application with a focus on developing reading, writing, and communication skills. A disadvantage for families using this application is that directions are only provided in the English language.

For students encountering difficulties, there are writing voice prompts to guide them through the writing process. Students will be able to keep a record of their past entries to reread and reflect. As stated in the application description provided, iDiary is beneficial for English Language Learners because it “promotes self-discovery, independence, and writing skills as well as expression, self-confidence, and creativity which produces a positive learning environment within the classroom. The application also fosters family engagement since students can share their journal entries with family members by showcasing them for everyone to see. Teachers also have the ability to email or post entries to social media feeds for a more interactive experience.
